

Propagation Methods Explained

Introduction Clivia can be multiplied in two primary ways: division and seed. Each has unique advantages.

Division - Separate offshoots from mature plants. - Best done after flowering season. - Produces true-to-type offspring.

Seed Propagation - Sow fresh seeds in moist, well-drained medium. - Germination may take 4–6 weeks. - Produces genetic variation, useful for breeding.

Tips - Label divisions and seedlings clearly. - Keep seedlings shaded until established.
