

A flower qualifies as having a green throat if there is a significant green throat present in the flower. The depth and extent of the green throat colour is important in assessing the flower, as the deeper the colour and more extensive the distribution of the green colour, the better the quality of the green throat.

Flowers with an insignificant green throat present may be entered in the flower colour category 'without green throats' and will neither be penalised nor advantaged by virtue of the presence of the insignificant green.
