

# Bicolor Flowers

The Bicolour refers to the individual tepal. The throat colour must extend beyond 50 % of the length of the tepal up until 90 %.

If the throat colour is greater than 90 %, it is not a bicolor tepal but a picotee tepal

Under 50 % it would be a 'normal' tepal colouring



## Large Throated (Bicolor):



Between 50% and 90% of the tepal length is the throat color.
