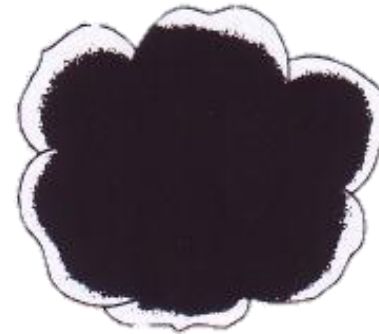


# Picotee Flowers

The throat of the tepal should be 90% or more but less than 100 % of the length of the tepal.

The rim of tepal colour is less than 10 % of the length of the tepal, around the distal or outer end of the tepal.

There should be a clear demarcation between the outer rim and the throat colour. The rim should give the appearance of a continuous ring of colour around the edges of the flower.



Greater than 90% of the tepal length is the throat color, with enough coloration across the tips to create a ring around the flower.

This can be referred to as a "Geneva Edge" when the ring is white.
