Interspecific Hybrids

Interspecific hybrids are hybrids between different Clivia species (Duncan 2008 p.17). Interspecific hybrid – This includes any cross between two or more species of Clivia. Should this interspecific plant be crossed with any other species or with itself, this plant remains an interspecific. (Clivia Society Judging standards)

Bell Shape

The tepals move outward from the vertical axis of the flower at the proximal end, near the ovary.
