

Interspecific Hybrids

Interspecific hybrids are hybrids between different Clivia species (Duncan 2008 p.17).

Interspecific hybrid – This includes any cross between two or more species of Clivia. Should this interspecific plant be crossed with any other species or with itself, this plant remains an interspecific. (Clivia Society Judging standards)

Trumpet Shape

The tepals are almost parallel to the vertical axis in the proximal part of the flower and then flare outwardly at the open end of the flower.
