Interspecific Hybrids

Interspecific hybrids are hybrids between different Clivia species (Duncan 2008 p.17).

Interspecific hybrid – This includes any cross between two or more species of Clivia. Should this interspecific plant be crossed with any other species or with itself, this plant remains an interspecific. (Clivia Society Judging Standards)

Tubular Shape

Flowers that have tepals that runs almost parallel to the vertical axis of the flower.

(This is kept, as pendulous crosses amongst the 5 species are still and Interspecific, which most likely will still present as Tubular Shape)
