## **Nobilis x Mirabilis**

Plant has a 9 leaf offset. Small to medium plant with purple stem. Leaves are stiff and Nobilis like. Flowers are orange/red and Mirabilis like.





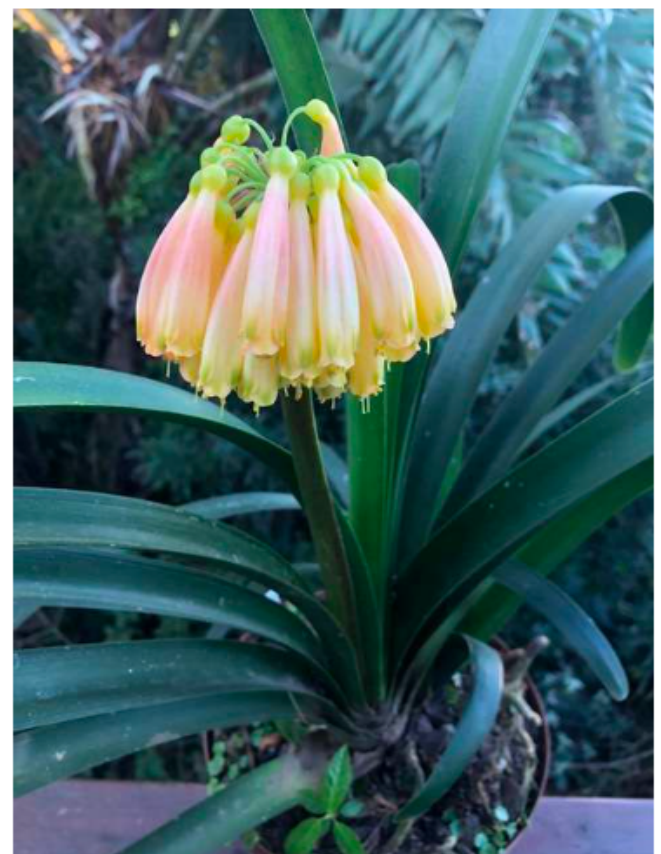
# LOT 4

## **Wesley No. 1**



Established 11 leaf offset from original mother plant. Exceptional Nobilis close, small semi-compact, vigorous. Amazing colour. Found in 2008 flowering in a sangoma's garden in Peddie District, Eastern Cape. Extremely unusual colour variation from almost white/yellow to pink cerise as it ages. A true blush yellow. This plant has a reserved price.



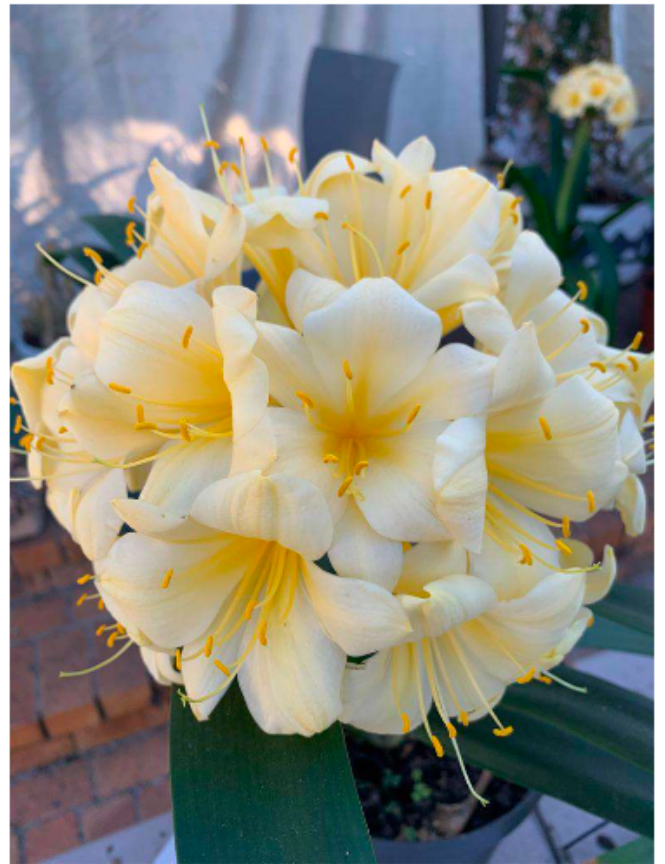
# LOT 5

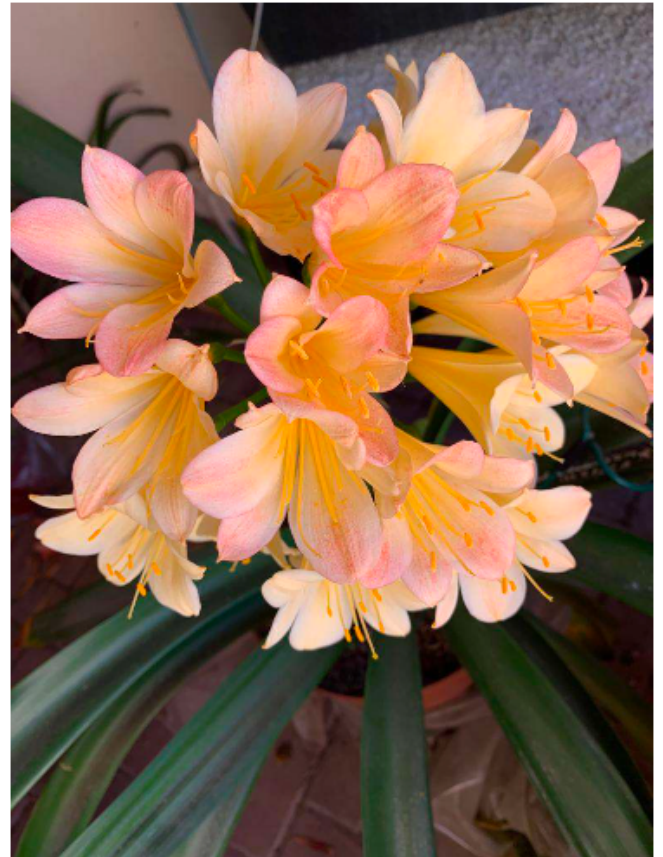


# LOT 6

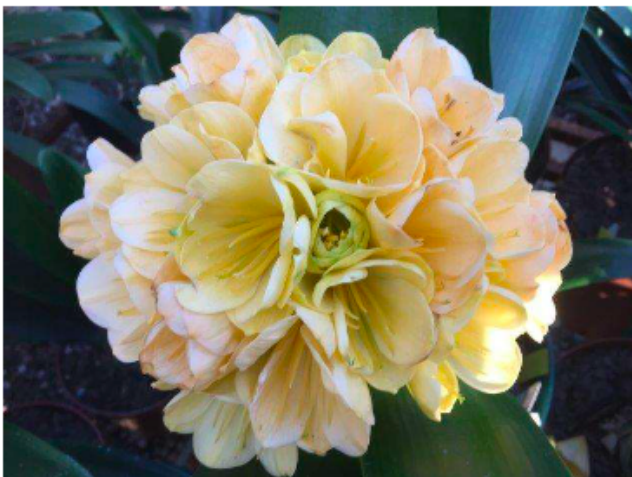

## **Nefertiti Gold (NG)**

NG is a compact broad leaf multitepal yellow that occasionally blushes right at the end. As pollen parent, using it on some of our Hattori plants, it has produced our full range of flowering Tangelos exhibiting an incredibly diverse range of true picotees as well as splashed picotees.

As pod parent it continues to produce yellow and splashed yellow multitepal daruma offspring. The pods clearly reveal the multitepal characteristics. (The pods will not be included in the sale).

This is the first offset of this plant offered for sale. It has also not been sold privately to anyone yet. There is a reserve price on this plant which will be handed over at the conference to the auctioneer.
